RE: 2011-2012 Annual Improvement Goals-Revised and APPROVED

As a result of data analysis, the District's School Improvement Advisory Committee recommends the following annual improvement goals for 2011-2012.

### **UCSD Long Range Goal – Reading**

There will be an increase in the percent of students who are proficient in reading comprehension.

#### **2011-2012 Annual Improvement Goal – Reading**

- Using matched cohort data (students in 2010-2011 to same students 2011-2012), there will be an increase in the percentage of students in the total proficient (advanced and proficient combined) and a decrease in the percentage of students in the less than proficient level of proficiency in each of grades 4-8 and 10-11 on the Iowa Assessments for Reading Comprehension.

### **UCSD Long Range Goal – Mathematics**

There will be an increase in the percent of students who are proficient in mathematics.

#### **2011-2012 Annual Improvement Goal– Mathematics**

- Using matched cohort data (students in 2010-2011 to same students 2011-2012), there will be an increase in the percentage of students in the total proficient (advanced and proficient combined) and a decrease in the percentage of students in the less than proficient level of proficiency in each of grades 4-8 and 10-11 on the Iowa Assessment Math Total.

### **UCSD Long Range Goal – Science**

There will be an increase in the percent of students who are proficient in science.

#### **2011-2012 Annual Improvement Goal – Science**

- Using matched cohort data (students in 2010-2011 to same students 2011-2012), there will be an increase in the percentage of students in the total proficient (advanced and proficient combined) and a decrease in the percentage of students in the less than proficient level of proficiency in each of grades 5, 8, 10 and 11 on the Iowa Assessment for Science.
