2017-2018 GOALS

- 89.1% of 3rd - 5th Grade students will be proficient or advanced in the area of reading as measured by the Iowa Assessments Reading test. 97% of 3rd grade students will be considered literate as measured by Iowa Assessments or FAST assessment data by the 2020-2021 school year.
- 86.2% of 3rd - 5th Grade students will be proficient or advanced in the area of math as measured by the Iowa Assessments Mathematics test.
- 93.6% of 3rd - 5th Grade students will be proficient or advanced in the area of science as measured by the Iowa Assessments Science test.
- 80% of 5th grade students will be engaged and 60% will be hopeful as measured by the Gallup Student Poll scales in the 2015-2016 school year.
- Rolling Green will be at the 98th percentile rank for Employee Engagement as measured by the Gallup Q12 Engagement Poll in the 2017-18 school year.
- 85% of parent respondents will report satisfaction with supporting student success for the 2017-18 school year on the Studer Education survey.

STRATEGIES

- Make instructional decisions based on student data during PLCs, 30 day check-ins and 60 reviews.
- Provide Professional Development to respond to student and staff needs.
- Use continuous improvement approach to strengthen building-wide systems.
- Emphasize student and staff celebrations publically.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES & PRACTICES

- Project Based Learning.
- Small group targeted instruction.
- Large group instruction that lasts no longer than 5 minutes past student's age.
- Differentiated instruction and materials.
- Technology tools in all classrooms.
- Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) Process that involves staff & student input.
