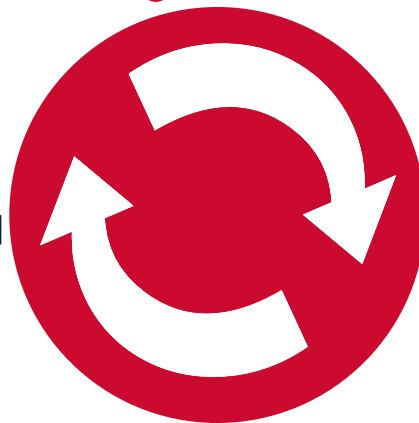
Urbandale Community School District has a total of three instructional delivery models which include On Site, Hybrid, and Required Continuous Learning for the 2020-21 school year. The reason for these three models is to ensure that we are supporting student learning in the safest way possible by being responsive to the status of public health. We are prepared to transition between models provided the governor continues the Public Health Disaster proclamation and public health dictates the need for transitioning instructional delivery due to the current status of COVID-19 community spread.

On Site



All students and staff are on site for in-person instruction. Attendance is mandatory and student participation is required*.

Hybrid



Students would attend school on site for two days per week (Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs) and Required Continuous Learning (online) from home for three days per week (all remote on Fridays). Attendance is mandatory and student participation is required. Approximately half of all students would be on site at any given time.

Online



All students and staff are engaged in Required Continuous Learning remotely (all online). Attendance is mandatory and student participation is required.

*Alternative Learning Options

Remote Classroom: Students complete coursework from home with online guidance and interaction with a district teacher. Starting 8/25/20.

Home Schooling: Students complete coursework from home. Parents responsible for all aspects of instruction, lesson delivery, and assessment.

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
