Return To Learn Dashboard View v.2

Urbandale Community School District has a total of three instructional delivery models which include On Site, Hybrid, and Required Continuous Learning. All instruction for the 2020-21 school year will take place utilizing one of these three models at any given time. School districts only have the authority to transition between On Site & Hybrid models & will have to seek permission from the Iowa Dept of Education to move a school or district to the Required Continuous Learning (all online) model. Families have a choice of two alternative learning options if they do not want their children in a school building this year: Remote Classroom or Home Schooling.

3 Instructional Models



1) On Site

All students and staff are on site 5 days a week for in-person instruction. Implementing preventative measures such as face masks, hand hygiene & physical distancing when possible.

2) Hybrid



Students learn both in school & online. The July 17 Proclamation changed the requirements for Hybrid models to require at least 50% of in-person instruction to occur over a two-week period. We're updating our Hybrid model as needed to meet the new requirement. More info coming early August.

3) Online

All students & staff are engaged in Required Continuous Learning remotely (all online). Districts must be granted permission from DE to transition to this model.

Family Choice: 2 Alternative Learning Options

1) Remote Classroom

Students complete coursework from home with online instruction with district teachers. Families can sign up one semester at a time. Sign up by August 3 for the first semester.

2) Home Schooling

Students complete coursework from home. Parents responsible for all aspects of instruction, lesson delivery, and assessment. Inform district by August 10 if choosing to homeschool.
