Rolling Green Start of School Year Updates

Rolling Green Families,

I'd like to provide several updates regarding decisions that were approved during last night's School Board meeting. Please review these updates and also direct your attention to the forms that may require your response if you have not yet completed them.

Required Continuous Learning (all online)

The Board voted unanimously for Rolling Green to start on July 23 in the Required Continuous Learning (all online) instructional model. Although this is the model we'll start the school year in, I'm hopeful that we'll be in a position soon to transition to having students and teachers back in the classroom together. Back in school is where we would ideally be!

Please know, we recognize the challenges online learning presents for our families and we are working through ideas to help reduce barriers. I will be sharing more information soon about what to expect for a typical school day in our online learning model, what to expect for a typical daily/weekly schedule for online learning, and classroom lists.

Face Masks

The Board also unanimously approved requiring face masks for K-12 students and staff when in a school building unless a medical condition or special circumstance is documented. If your Rolling Green student has a medical condition or special circumstance, [please complete this form by July 18](#).

Chromebooks

As we'll start our school year with online learning, we'd like to ensure that all kindergarten through 5th grade students have a Chromebook.
